

# The Enright's Economical "Tub Scope"

Getting the Plexiglas cut for free at the local hardware store, and constructing the scope themselves, Dick and Betsy's Tub Scope cost them less than \$10!

The Tub Scope is fairly easily constructed with the tools and materials shown here.



The scope has a large view area, approximately 10" x 15". The Plexiglas is glued to the inside of the tub with liberal amount of glue, weighted and left to dry overnight.

The top is attached with cable tie "hinges."



The tub scope can be towed behind your kayak or canoe then pulled alongside for viewing. The hinged top can be manually adjusted to shield the Plexiglas view window from the sunlight.
