Interested in gaining real-world experience while working to protect Maine lakes?

Interns will work closely with Volunteer Lake Monitoring Program (VLMP) staff and volunteers. Learning opportunities abound, and vary from day to day. All interns are encouraged to participate in, and later assist with, VLMP volunteer training workshops. Workshops cover a variety of topics including water quality monitoring, screening waterbodies for invasive aquatic plants, volunteer leadership, and more.

Interns should be prepared to assist the permanent staff with routine administrative tasks, such as data entry and the preparation of informational materials for volunteers. Critical attention to detail and accuracy is absolutely essential!

Interns will be paid \$11.00 hourly, and will need to be available on several weekends and evenings during the summer. *Position is based in Auburn, ME*.

Interns are responsible for their own housing and transportation, and should have a clean, valid driver's license.

- Help conduct volunteer training workshops
- Assist volunteers during 'hands-on' activities
- Collect, process and catalog live plant specimens
